Teambuilding initiatives and programs at Butter and Egg Adventures are designed to engage participants in challenging situations that are metaphors for problems and situations they face in everyday life. (Jim Cain and Barry Jolliff: Teamwork & Teamplay) Activities are structured to be mentally, emotionally, and/or physically challenging. This means that participants may stand on their feet, bend, stretch, or move more than they do in a typical day. Activities are held primarily outdoors which may include dealing with heat, cold, humidity, insects, or sunlight. While facilitators try to make use of comfortable conditions (i.e., shade instead of direct sunlight in summer months) and work to accommodate disabilities that are disclosed in advance, the foundation of challenge and adventure programming is just as stated....to create some level of *challenge* so that individuals will stretch their comfort zones and learn something new. Please prepare your group, in advance of the event day, with this information and encourage questions they may have. All group members should be encouraged to participate to the best of their abilities, and they can trust that facilitators will not intentionally place them in embarrassing situations. Waiver Completion and Submission

Ensure that each participant submits a completed, **on-line waiver**. Parents of youth under age 18 must complete waivers for minors, and adults must complete their own waiver. Please contact us, a few days in advance of your event, if you would like a list of all participants who have successfully completed the on-line waiver. Adults may also sign on-line waivers upon arrival to your event; however, *advance submission of waivers will reduce waiting time once your group arrives*. MOTE: Waivers are electronic, do not attempt to print waivers from computer in order to bring to the event.

Billing and Payment Policies

- Deposit is due within 7 days of proposal confirmation. Payment may be made by online payment at butterandeggadventures.com or by check to Butter and Egg Adventures; 2127 Butter and Egg Rd; Troy, Al 36081
- The balance of payment for services and reservations is due upon arrival unless prior arrangements have been made.
